To Prepare:

Outside of courage and an open heart, the only thing you need to bring is a true fiveminute story that you are willing to share about an **object** that holds significant meaning in your life.

Your stories can be anchored in joy, pain, connection, hope. The object could be a family photograph, or your favourite book for example. We would like you to bring the object with you on the day, if this isn't possible please bring a photo of the object with you.

Remember, each of us is made up of countless stories, but during our time together we would like for you to share just one story from your life, no longer than 5 minutes.

We will guide you through the process and model a story for you on the day. We look forward to meeting you and guiding you through the Story Exchange experience!
