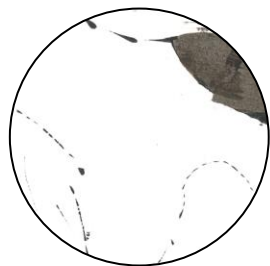

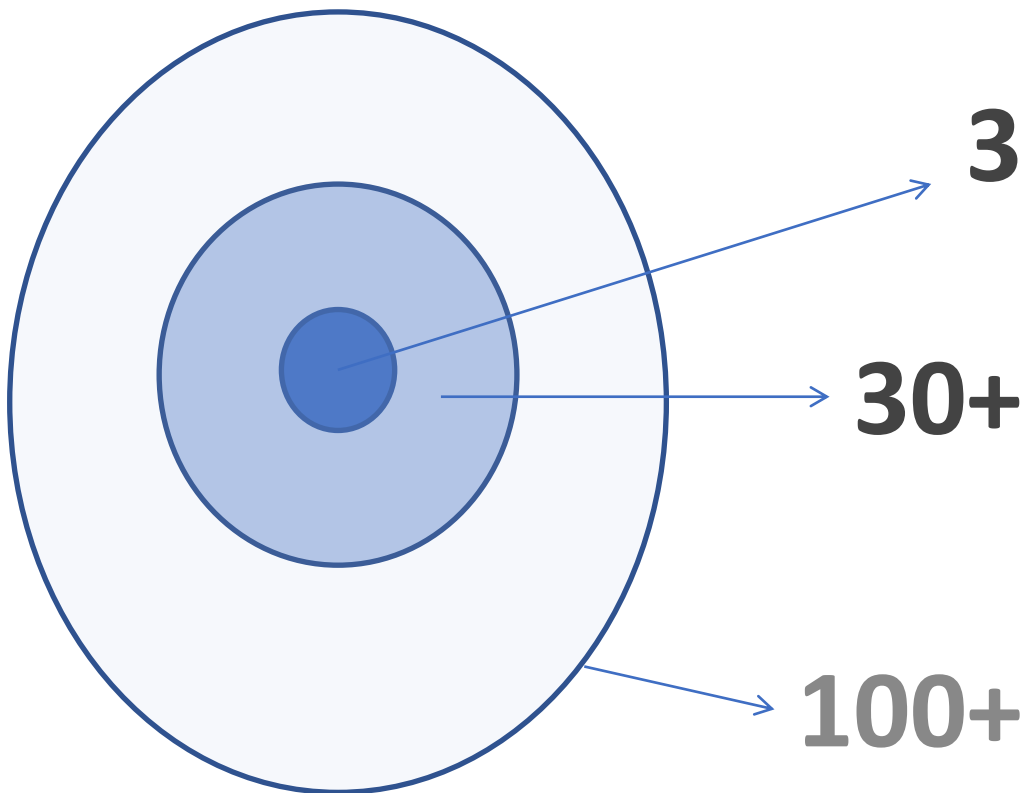

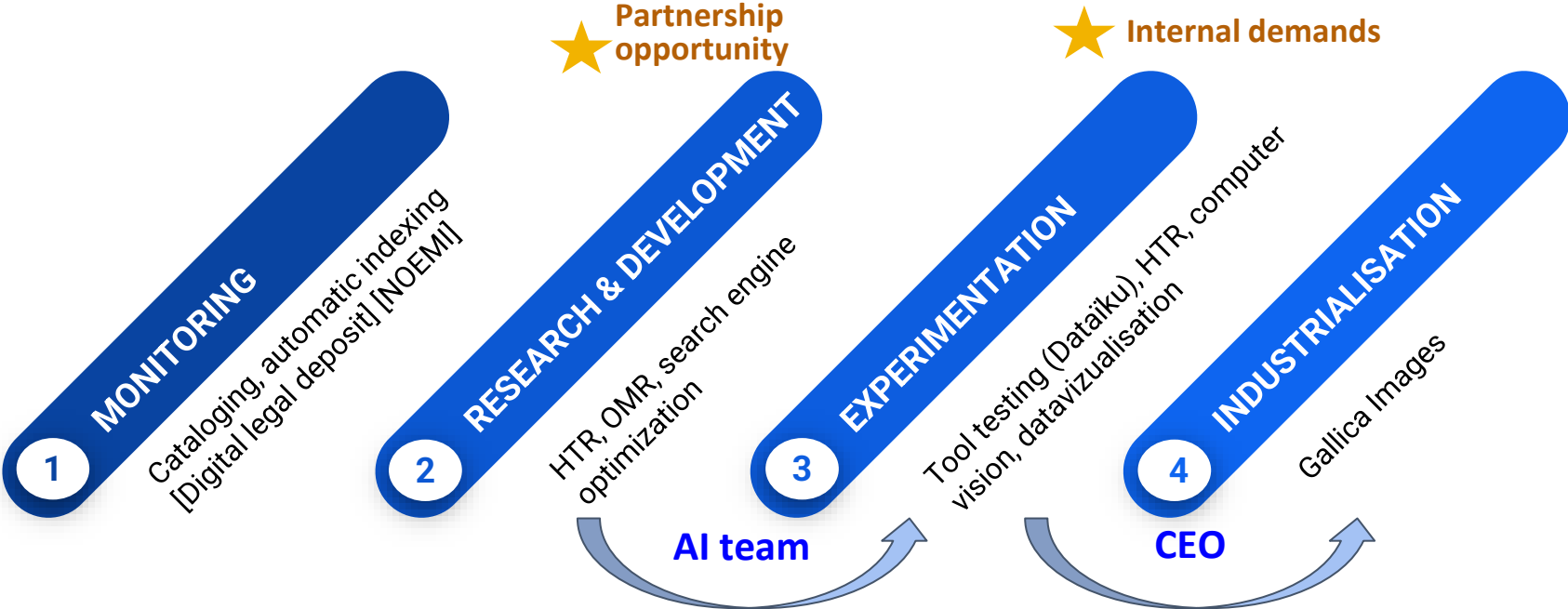
« AI team » of **3** members with **complementary skills**:

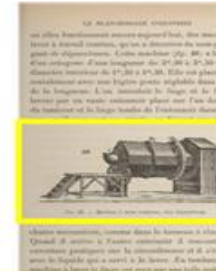

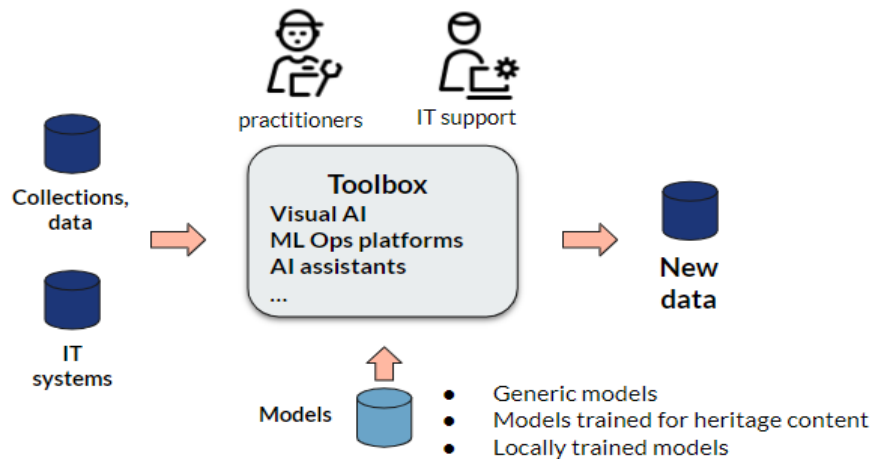
## Querying images in the whole Gallica collection based on AI-generated keywords

- **Segmenting** all images (50M?) in Gallica ( $\approx$  250M pages)
- Automatic image **indexing**
- Providing **access** (API, IIIF)

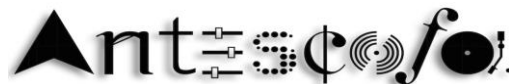

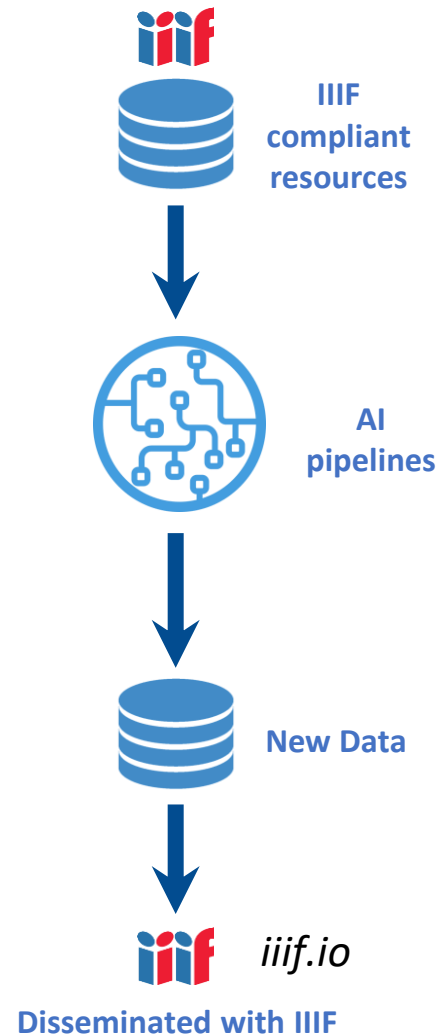
